
The 2008 ONTARIO HEALTH & SAFETY REGULATIONS STATE :

SECTION 33.
(1) A work surface shall be kept free of ,

(a) obstructions and hazards;
(b) cracks, holes & bumps that may endanger a worker; and
(c) accumulations of refuse, snow and ice
the provisions of drainage adequate in the circumstances







